

Cable tray industry standard thickness



Overview

Minimum thickness should be ≥ 1.5 mm for industrial use; ≥ 2.0 mm for high-load or outdoor environments. Verify supplier certifications and audit history for compliance assurance. Test for load-bearing capacity (up to 50 kg/m) and deflection limits. From an engineering standpoint, cable tray dimensions are not.
