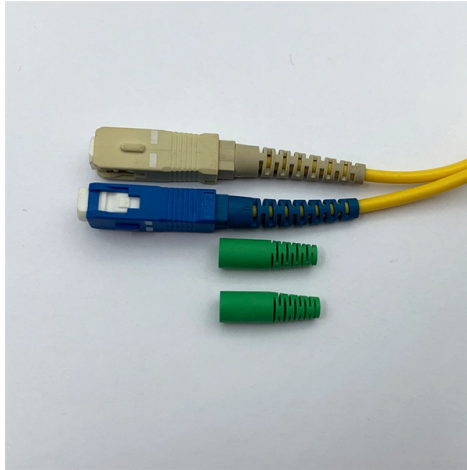


Clear distance between cable tray and ceiling



Overview

Leave 12" in between the tray and ceiling/building truss structure. When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. Can't tell you for Canada, but in the US (NEC) there is no distance requirement (assuming no splicing / boxes or special conditions), just the common sense of being able get your hands in there to dress the cables in the tray. These systems, made from metal or plastic, are open structures designed to support electrical conductors, ensuring proper organization and safety. The standard NEMA lengths for cable tray are 12, 20, 24 and 30-feet, although some manufacturers like Eaton offer cable tray in lengths up to 40 feet.

Telecommunications Horizontal Cabling and Support Structure

Cable tray will have 12" of clearance above and 6" below. No cable may be attached to conduit, pipes, any other utility structure, or laid on top of ceiling tile.
