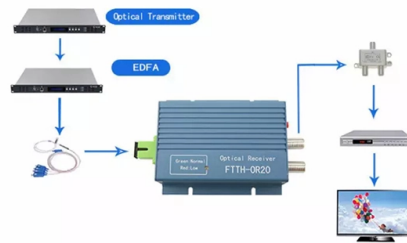


Follow-up to the severed national telecommunications fiber optic cable



Overview

Seven months after a subsea fiber optic line break near Prudhoe Bay, sea ice conditions are almost safe enough for two vessels, IT Integrity and Canpac Valkyrie, to begin repairs. This incident—impacting landlines, cellular service, internet access, and more—mirrors the then-unprecedented broadband crisis (ICAS) Director of Natural Resources and Tribal Secretary.
