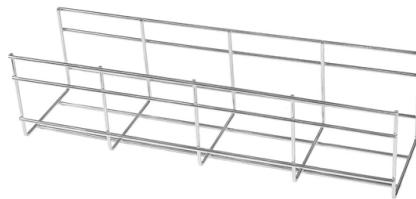


Mobile Optical Cable Color Scheme

Single mode fibers use yellow outer jacket, while multimode optical fibers use orange, aqua, violet, lime green to help quickly identify different types of multimode.
