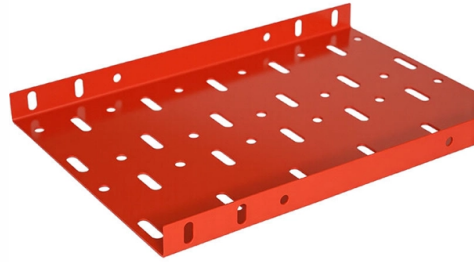


Traditional Optical Cable Splicing
